#### **Fun In Athletics**

In order to combat the winter blahs, Mr. K and Ms. Mainolfi have set up the Fun In Athletics equipment in the gym. This is an opportunity for classes to engage in a variety of activities that are not "typical" while improving fitness levels, and skills.

This is a circuit of various activities that keep children engaged and keep active. They are not your typical types of activities such as hopping, jumping and running around obstacles and racing. Following our Ash Wednesday liturgy they take them out and leave them out for a couple of weeks to engage in physical education class and it is fun for them. It was also mentioned that Mr. K kept a couple of students behind to demonstrate the circuit to the other students.
